


SARA Overview The Current SARA Landscape

Why is data collection important?

- Transparency:
 - Which institutions are enrolling online students?
 - Where are those students located?
- Measuring the impact of SARA:
 - Now have 3 years of online enrollment data.
 - Reports on the website.

SARA DATA Overview Out-of-State Learning Placements



Out-of-State Learning Placements:

- Clinicals/student teaching/internships.
- Voluntary for 2018 Required for 2019.
- Important parts of many academic programs.
- Number/extent of such placements are of interest:
 - Educators
 - Practitioners
 - Licensing bodies
 - State regulators



SARA DATA Overview Out-of-State Learning Placements



Summary:

- First-ever data gathering on this activity.
- Data is aggregated and summarized.
- 297 institutions reported student placements:
 - Institutions of all types and sizes reported.
 - 16% of SARA participating institutions reported.



What's New & Notable?



- Report Enrollment from Home State.
- Report Out-of-State Learning Placements (OOSLP).
- Enrollment Form Includes All Territories.
- Use Comments Fields to Report Anomalies and/or Concerns.
- 2019 Data Reporting Handbook provides guidance and reporting instructions.
- Reporting Window: May 14-June 4, 2019.

Three general points of guidance:

- Report enrollments as you do to IPEDS including associated definitions, etc.;
- Enlist the help of the person who does your institution's reporting to IPEDS (because they are intimately familiar with the world according to IPEDS'); and
- If in doubt, use your best professional judgment, exercised within the spirit and intent of SARA.






Determine **Who** will coordinate reporting internally.

Enrollment Reporting





Out-of-State Learning Placements Examples:

- Clinical Rotations
- Student Teaching
- Internships

Most often in health-related disciplines and Education, they are often a required part of obtaining a degree and/or license to practice a profession.



CIP CODES

 Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) is to provide a taxonomic scheme that supports the accurate tracking, assessment, and reporting of fields of study and program completion activity.

 NC-SARA uses the 47 two-digit CIP codes that represent program areas.

Where are these numbers kept on campus?

- Start with Institutional Research.
- In the academic departments that have learning placements.
- Document your approach to ensure consistency each year.

Criteria for Inclusion

Report out-of-state placements that meet all the following criteria:

- 1. The placement is outside the "home state" of the SARA institution;
- The placement involves the physical presence of the student at the out-ofstate location(s);
- 3. The placement is an activity required for degree completion or professional licensure;
- 4. The placement is offered for credit and/or offered for a fee; and
- 5. The placement started between January 1, 2018, and December 31, 2018.



Example #1

Three University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP) nursing students each do a single clinical rotation at each of two hospitals in Las Cruces, New Mexico, and one rotation at a hospital in Phoenix, Arizona.

UTEP would report three placements in New Mexico and three placements in Arizona, all under CIP code 51, Health Professions and Related Programs.

Example #2

A student at University of Colorado at Denver (UCD) participated in an OOSLP in spring 2018 under CIP code 13 in Arkansas; this same student then participated in another OOSLP in fall 2018 under CIP code 46 in Washington.

UCD would report two placements, one in each state. If both learning placements were in the same state, both placements would be reported, one under each CIP Code.
