### SARA and State-Mandated Tuition Refund Policies

#### How do state-mandated tuition refund policies apply to SARA-participating institutions?

##### What does the *SARA Policy Manual* Say?

**Subsection 2.5.j**, “The state agrees that, if it has requirements, standards, fees, or procedures for the approval and authorization of non-domestic institutions of higher education providing distance education in the state, it will not apply those requirements, standards, fees, or procedures to any non-domestic (out-of-state) institution that participates in SARA; instead, the state will apply those specifically prescribed in or allowed by SARA policies.”

Accordingly, SARA-participating institutions are to apply the tuition refund policies of their home state to their SARA students located in other SARA member states.

##### What does my institution need to do?

- Monitor for students in need of tuition refunds.
- Verify that students in need of tuition refunds are located in a SARA member state.
- Contact your state’s [SARA State Portal Entity](#) for specific guidance or directions on your state’s tuition refund policies.

1. SARA State Portal Entities have the responsibility and authority to hold institutions in compliance with SARA policy.
